Analysis

Thank you to the 108 parents who completed the questionnaire – Your feedback helps school improve and allows us to shape our ethos. This year we have worked hard to improve arts provision in school. We are working closely with Opera North: In Harmony and developing our links with the West Yorkshire Playhouse and the Grand Theatre. We have also purchased a kiln – look out for some pottery creations.

Overall, we are very pleased with the feedback you have provided. The staff and governors are very proud of the results. This level of parental support and positivity confirms our feelings – New Bewerley Community School is a great place to learn and work.

Areas to address...

This school deals effectively with bullying - 11% disagreed with this statement

12 people disagreed with this statement. Bullying is not tolerated at New Bewerley Community School. Although, we do acknowledge that children may tease one another and occasionally bully, all staff know how to deal with incidents of bullying. At New Bewerley we provide several additional adults to help resolve any bullying. These include Jemma Seavers (Learning Mentor), Louise Shea (Family Support Worker) and Angela Lockwood (Behaviour Support Worker). If parents or carers have any concerns about their child's safety please contact school immediately. We will always make time to listen to your concerns. School's anti-bullying policy is included in the behaviour policy. This is reviewed by governors every 2 years.

This school ensures the pupils are well behaved – 6% disagreed with this statement

6 people disagreed with this statement. Similarly, last year 70% of 'the pupils thought the behaviour of pupils at my school is good'. This year, however, 84% of the school thought behaviour at school was good and 97% of pupils know that poor behaviour has consequences. As a school we are pleased that children know that negative behaviours are challenged. This shows that our behaviour policy and systems are embedded well across school. Mrs Lockwood is happy to meet with parents who want to discuss this issue further. School's behaviour policy is on the school website. This policy details how school manages poor behaviour.

This school responds well to any concerns I raise – 5% disagreed with this statement

5 people disagreed with this statement. In response to this feedback we are going to update our website to include a list of people who can help you if you have any concerns. We are always happy to listen. It is schools duty to safeguard your children and provide an excellent education.

IMPROVED – Last year 4% disagreed with 'My child receives appropriate homework for their age'. This is now only 2%. This year all teachers have audited homework provision and agreed on a reasonable amount to send home. Our new homework policy is on the school website.
